Re: Binyam Mohamed

I am writing to you in my role as Chairman of the All Party Parliamentary Group on Extraordinary Rendition.

As you know, British resident Binyam Mohamed has recently been charged under the US Military Commissions system. These Commissions contravene established principles of law and the requirements of a fair trial. Does it remain the position of the UK Government that a fair trial is not possible under the current Military Commission system? If so, what action is being taken to ensure that Binyam Mohamed does not face charges before a Military Commission?
